

By public transport

Railway: station Brussels Central (11-minute walk) – station Brussels North (12-minute walk) – station Congrès (2-minute walk)

Tramway: stop “Botanique” (lines 92, 93) (2-minute walk)

Bus: stop “Saint-Louis” (lines 61, N18, 270, 271, 272), “Botanique” (line N04), “Rogier” (lines 58, 88), “Rue Traversière” (lines 65, 66)

Metro: stop “Botanique” (lines 2 & 6) (2-minute walk).

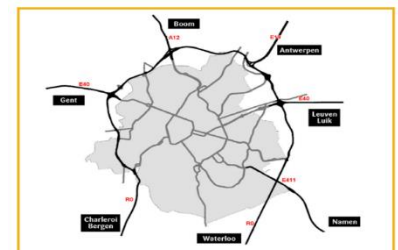
Bicycle parking in front of the building
