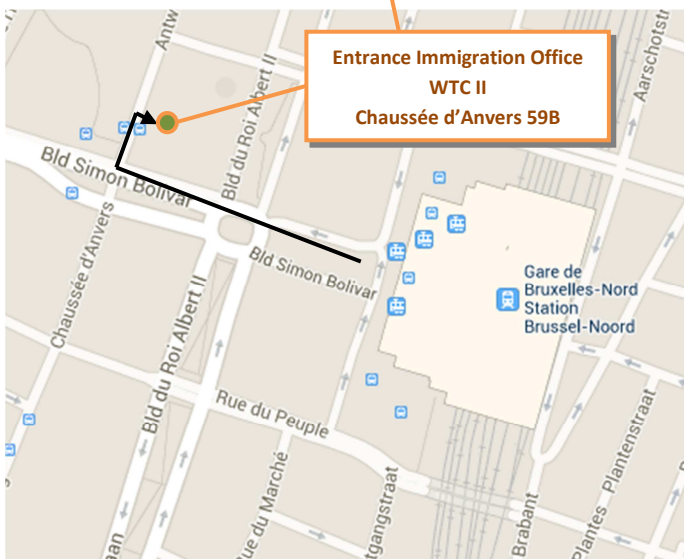

How to reach the Immigration Office by public transport

- **Train:** Brussels-North ("Bruxelles-Nord / Brussel-Noord") train station (200m: take the boulevard Simon Bolivar, the Chaussée d'Anvers is the second street to the right).
- **Tram:** Brussels-North ("Bruxelles-Nord / Brussel-Noord") tram stop, in the basement of the train station (200 m)
- **Bus:** lines 47 and 58 ("WTC" stop on the Chaussée d'Anvers).
lines 14, 57 and 88 ("WTC" stop on the corner of Boulevard Simon Bolivar and Chaussée d'Anvers).
- **Metro:** "Yser" metro station (800 m: take the "Boulevard Baudoin" exit, the Chaussée d'Anvers is immediately to the left). "Rogier" metro station (800m: take the "Place Rogier/Rogierplein" exit).
- **Airplane:** 3 trains per hour between Brussels Airport and Brussels-North

- **Tram/Bus & Metro:** the MIVB/STIB website or by phone (0032 70 23 2000 (0.30 €/min), from 8.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. on weekdays, from 8.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. during holiday season and from 8.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. on Saturdays).
